Social Equity: The group has come together and developed a survey in which to identify food education resources being utilized and barriers in which those that are low income feel withhold them from attending available resources within the city.

The Marketing/Outreach: the Marketing/Outreach group continues to support and promote endeavours that endorse the guidelines the Food Charter. It is also building partnerships with agencies trying to advocate activities supporting the Charter.

New Initiative at ACNBA

The Aids Committee of North Bay and Area has initiated a new program beginning this fall. The program aims to have their peers prepare meals in jar where they keep one, and prepare a second to give to another. The second meal will be given out to clients during their needle exchange program. Kathleen Jodouin, HIV Educator and MSM Outreach Coordinator says "It is way for our Peers to help other clients as well as receive a pre prepared meal." The meals only require heat source and water to be prepared once received. The first two recipes will be apple oatmeal and potato soup for October and November.
